Having the right stationery can set the wedding theme from the outset. Sally Lloyd explains how to get it right and get them delivered on time!

Your Invitations should be sent out 8-12 weeks before the wedding and remember to allow ample time to have them printed and delivered, and also allow time to address them and prepare them for posting. Ordering all your stationery from the same supplier will not only ensure consistency of design, but will also save time and money. You may want to order other wedding stationery to match your invitations and below is a guide to help you when ordering.

Save the Date Cards – 1 per household + a few extras
Invitations – 1 per household + a few extras
Reply Cards & Other Inserts – same as Invitations
Thank You Cards – 1 per household + a few extras
Order of Service – 1 per guest + the Vicar
Order of Ceremony – 1 per guest + the Registrar
Place Cards – 1 per guest + the Bride, Groom
and Head Table guests

Menus – 1 per guest or 3-4 per table Table Numbers/Names – 1 per table Table Plan – 1 at entrance of reception room

When ordering your Invitations, keep in mind that one Invitation is sent per household. Couples all too often make the mistake of thinking that if they're inviting 100 guests, that 100 Invitations are needed, however in actual fact only about half that amount will be needed because they're usually sent to couples and
